## DENTAL CARE PROGRAM "GIVE A SMILE"

The goal of the program is to provide dental and orthodontic services on a regular basis to children from orphanages and low-income families who are not funded by the state.

- in 2025, dental care was provided to 231 children.

Children from the following institutions participated in the program:

- **Almaty Regional Children's Home No. 1**

76 children with "orphan" and "left without parental care" status received dental treatment.

- **SOS Children's Village in Almaty**

50 children with "orphan" and "left without parental care" status received dental treatment.

- **Zhanuya Specialized Complex for Orphans**

59 children with "orphan" and "left without parental care" status received dental treatment.

- **Boarding School No. 10 for Children from Low-Income Families**

33 children from low-income families received dental treatment.



## DENTAL CARE PROGRAM “GIVE A SMILE”

- **Correctional boarding school No. 1**  
Ten children with hearing impairments received dental treatment.
- **One child from a large family and two children from a family receiving targeted social assistance** received dental treatment.

## GENERAL EXAMINATION AND FIELD HYGIENE LESSONS:

In 2025, the program provided comprehensive dental examinations and mobile oral hygiene lessons for more than **400 children** from specialized centers and children's institutions.

The children received not only knowledge, but also practical assistance—**individual kits with toothpaste and toothbrushes**, as well as support from volunteers—students who received the Zhakiya Sarsenova grant, who conducted educational games and classes.




# THE ZHAKIYA SARSENOVA EDUCATIONAL GRANT PROGRAM

The goal of the program is to identify and support graduates of orphanages and boarding schools from extremely low-income families. The program is aimed at students who have sufficient academic performance and motivation to continue their education.

**From 2012 to 2025**, as part of the Zhakiya Sarsenova Educational Grant program, **67 students** received full funding for their studies and a monthly scholarship from the Zhakiya Foundation. **48 graduates** of the program have become sought-after specialists.

In 2025, the Foundation awarded **three new grants to students**, including **a future doctor, dentist, and linguist**.

To date, **19 students** are continuing their education under the Zhakiya Sarsenova Educational Grant Program, studying **15 different subjects** at universities in **8 regions of Kazakhstan**.



The total amount of funding from 2012 to 2025 is:  
**165 459 199 tenge.**

# THE ZHAKIYA SARSENOVA EDUCATIONAL GRANT PROGRAM




We have successfully completed our four-year partnership with **Kazakhstan Ijara Company (KIC) JSC**, which lasted from September 2021 to May 2025.

Throughout this period, the Fund provided KIC JSC with quarterly financial reports on the use of charitable assistance.

Thanks to the sponsorship support of Kazakhstan Ijara Company JSC, the Zhakiya Foundation was able to fully cover the tuition costs for **14 students**, as well as provide them with a monthly scholarship for four years.

The training took place at **9 universities in Kazakhstan**, located in **4 regions** of the country (Almaty Region, Aktobe Region, Akmola Region, Turkestan Region) in **11 different specialties**.

Graduates of the educational program became qualified specialists in various fields. Among the specialties obtained were **teacher, journalist, financier, pharmacist, international lawyer, dentist, and doctor**.



The total amount of support provided was **57,918,608** tenge.

# EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SUPPORT PROGRAM

- “The ‘Back to School’ Initiative for Children in Alatau City and Koyankus Village”

The project supported 20 children from large and low-income families and orphaned children in preparation for the new academic year by providing all necessary items, including school supplies and school uniforms.



# EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SUPPORT PROGRAM

- **New Furniture for the Preschool Institution 'Bolashak', Araltobe Village, Aktobe Region.**

For the children of the 'Bolashak' preschool institution, the Foundation purchased certified children's furniture and **developmental equipment**, including dining tables and chairs, children's furniture, bookcases and combined shelving units, oval and sensory tables, a Pikler climbing structure with a climbing wall, stackable chairs, and wooden educational toys.



# EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SUPPORT PROGRAM

With the support of Eastomtrans LLP, furniture was manufactured and delivered to the “Senim” Center in the village of Maikomygen, Atyrau Region, where children with special needs are educated.



# EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SUPPORT PROGRAM

- “The ‘Be a Santa’ Project with the Participation of Employees of Eastcomtrans LLP, Remvagon LLP, TLC Zhetygen LLP, and ConECT-M LLP.”

Employees of the company participated in the charitable campaign ‘Be a Santa,’ bringing joy to **148 children**.

A total of **98 employees took part**, carefully and warmly selecting gifts.

The festive New Year atmosphere, together with Santa Claus and the Snow Maiden, was experienced by **63 children from the Regional Child Support Center in Konaev**, **57 children from the City Child Support Center in Almaty**, and **25 children from the ‘Kovcheg’ orphanage in Talgar**. Each child received a long-awaited gift and felt cared for and valued.
